### GOAL

Involving community people in all level of development aspects and making one village as a model village in terms of organic farming, women empowerment, youth skill up gradation, proper waste management system, reaching all government schemes, proper health facilities in village level, proper rain water and solar units etc.

## Objectives

- Establishment of waste management unit at village and segregating dry waste and wet waste with the help of SHG members which will be income source to SHG.
- Providing training to Panchayath members to identify their ward need and preparing action plan with the help of ward members and submitting to PDO.
- Establishment of solar energy livelihood models which will help youth and women to earn more income with less expenditure. Organizing skill based trainings and providing bank linkage to start self-employment.
- Community people easily assessing government schemes in one roof like ration, pension schemes, health schemes, housing schemes, scholarships, Bank loans, employment schemes etc.
- Ensuring 100% of local participation in Gramasabha and pressurizing government department to get government projects according to local need.
- Farmers practising organic farming system, establishment of soil test lab for 100% soil test and farmer clinic to get technical information about crop management, manure and market. Encouraging youth to practice integrated agriculture component and start agro related self-employment.
- Conducting regular health check-up camps, immunization camps, mental health camps and establishment of herbal medicinal plant at village.
- Encouraging community people to adopt rain water units, practise eco-friendly systems, plastic free village and actions to save nature.

- Organising camps on govt schemes
- Empowering the grass routes- Skill development for youths and grass routes
